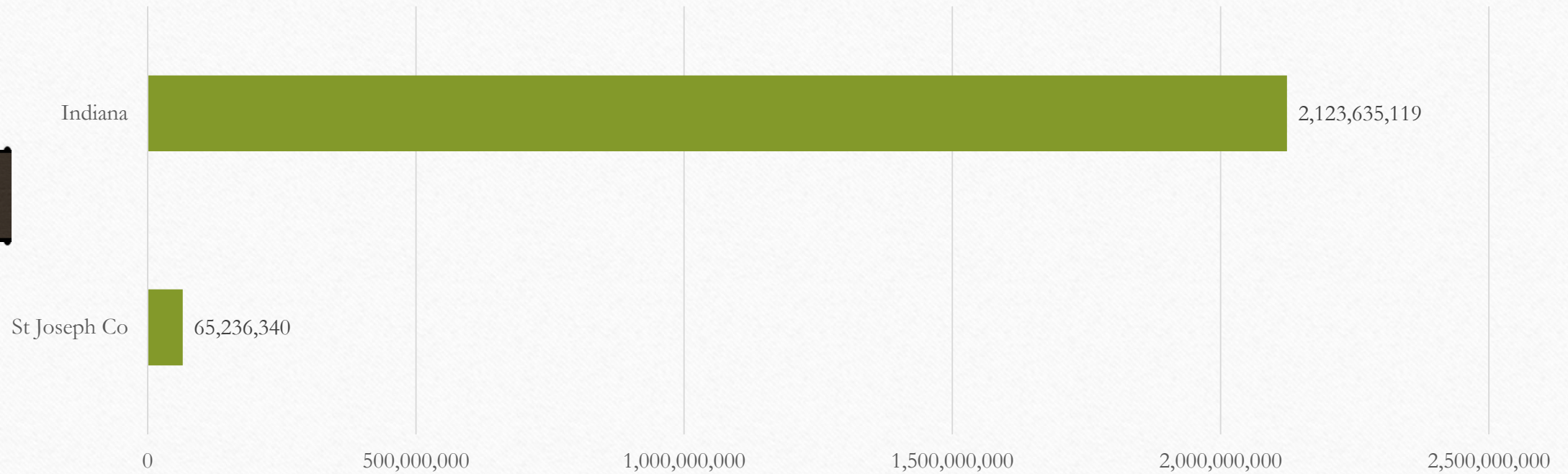

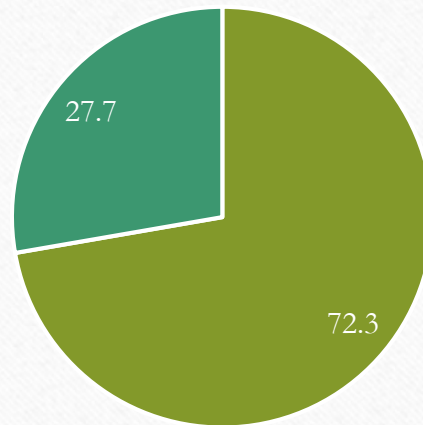

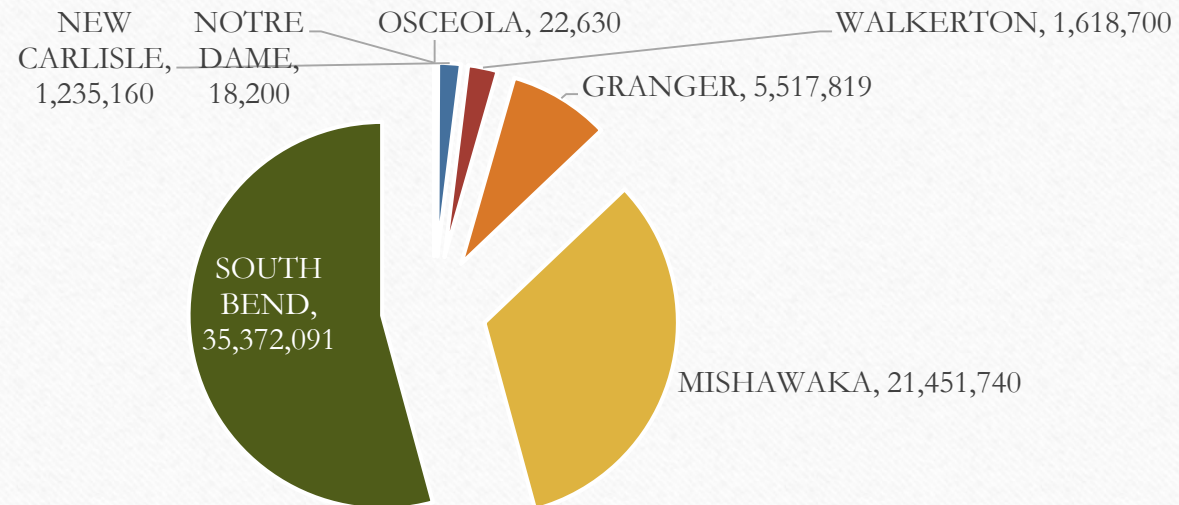

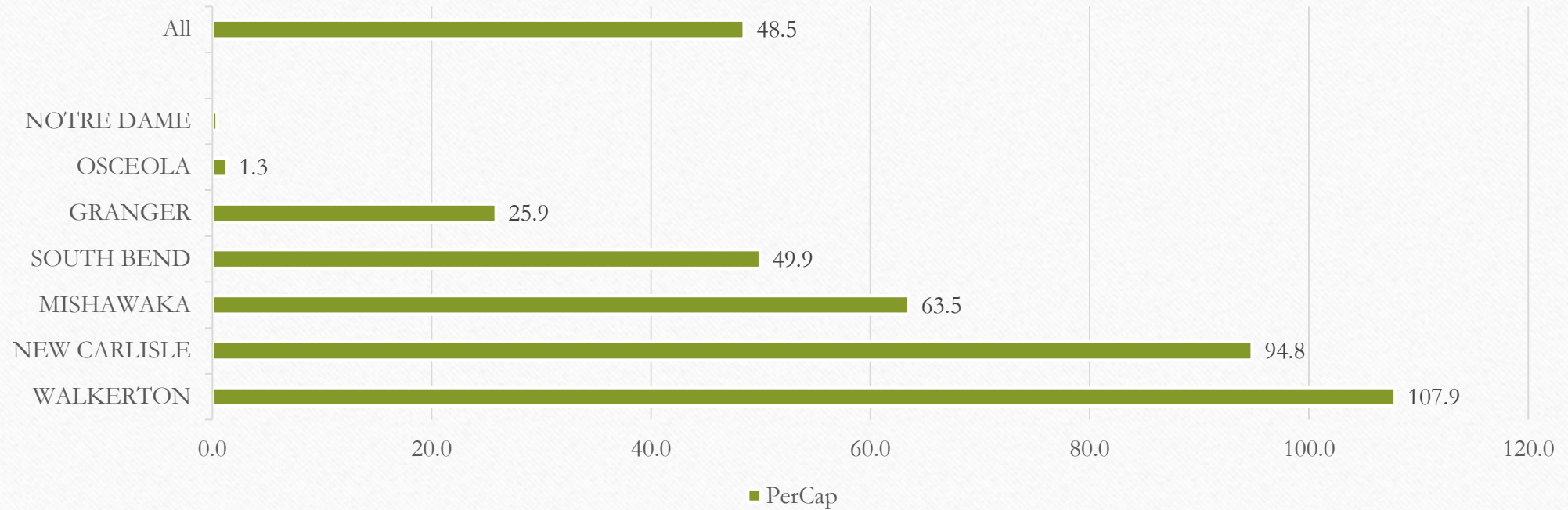

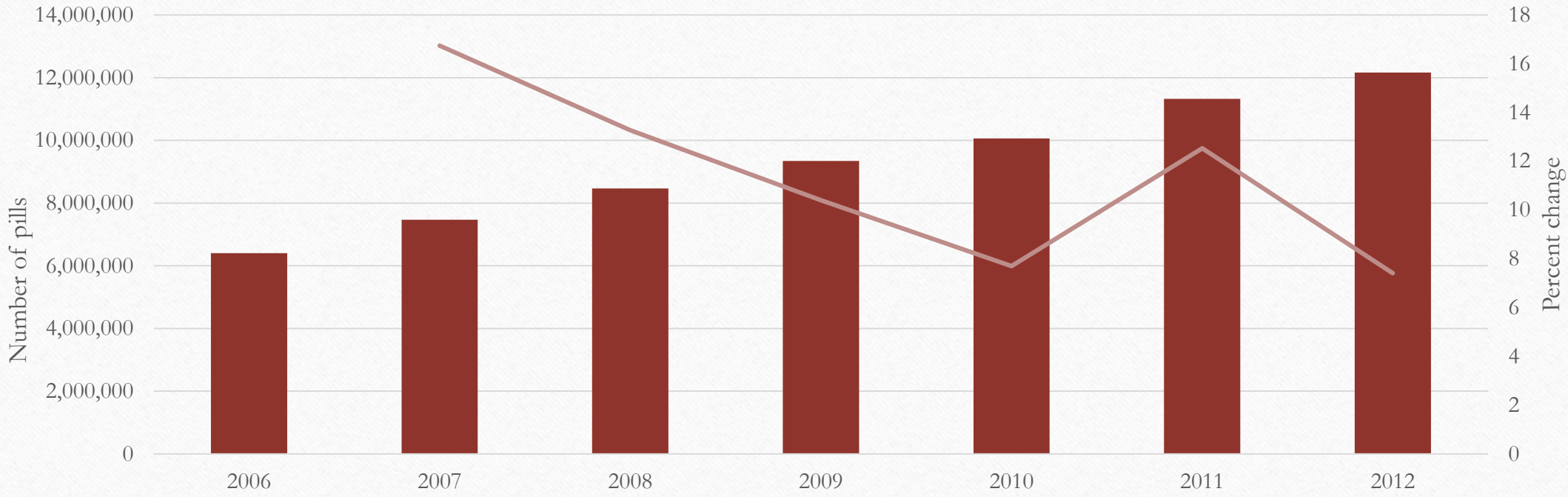
Opioids per Capita by City

St. Joseph County, 2006-2012



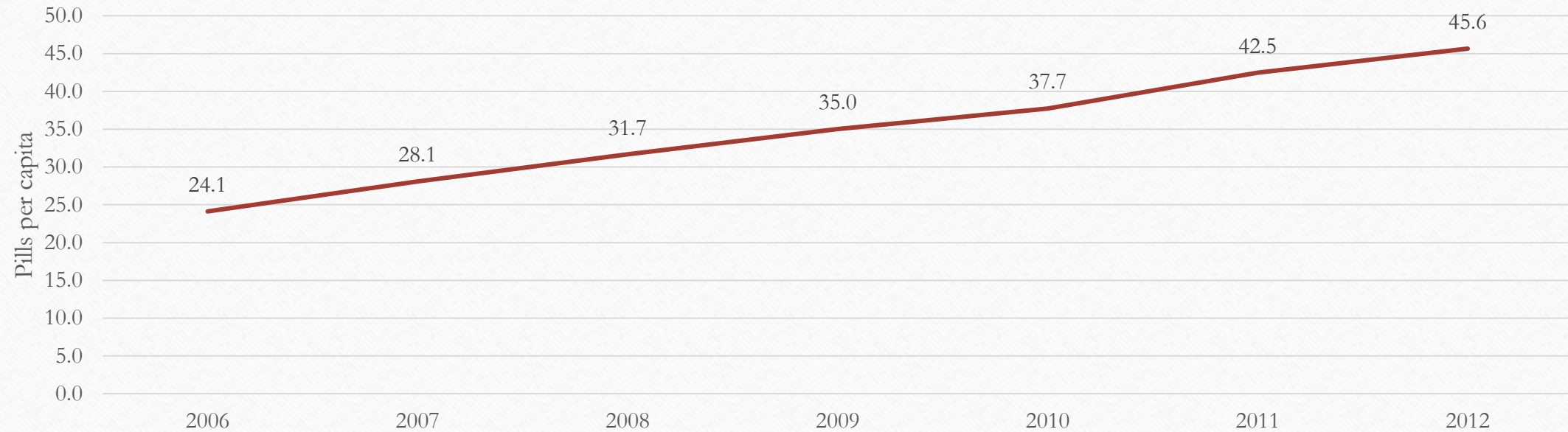
Total Pills by Year distributed and Percent Change

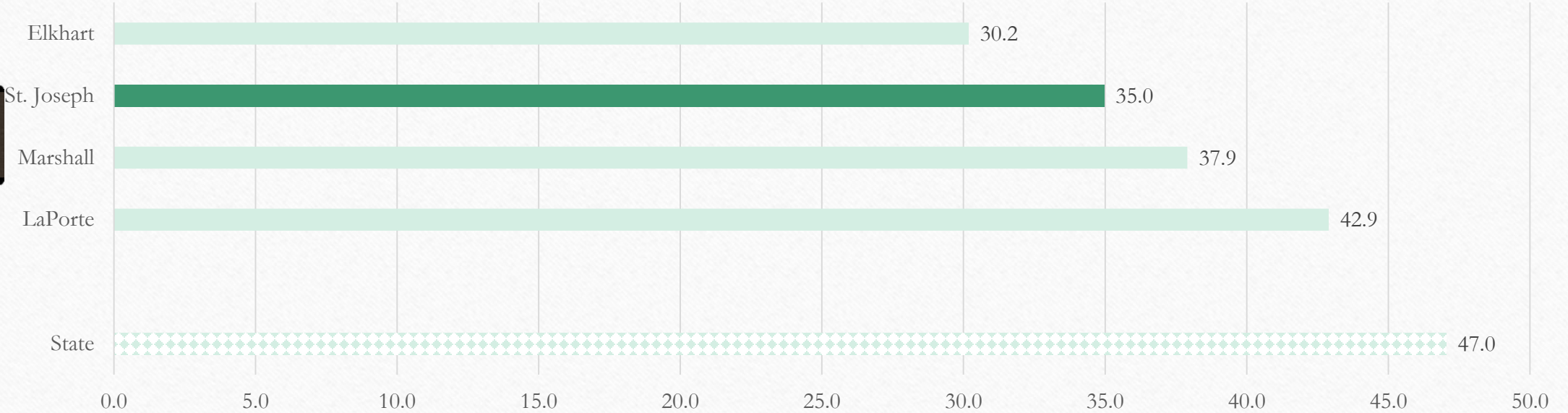
Total Pills per Capita by Year distributed

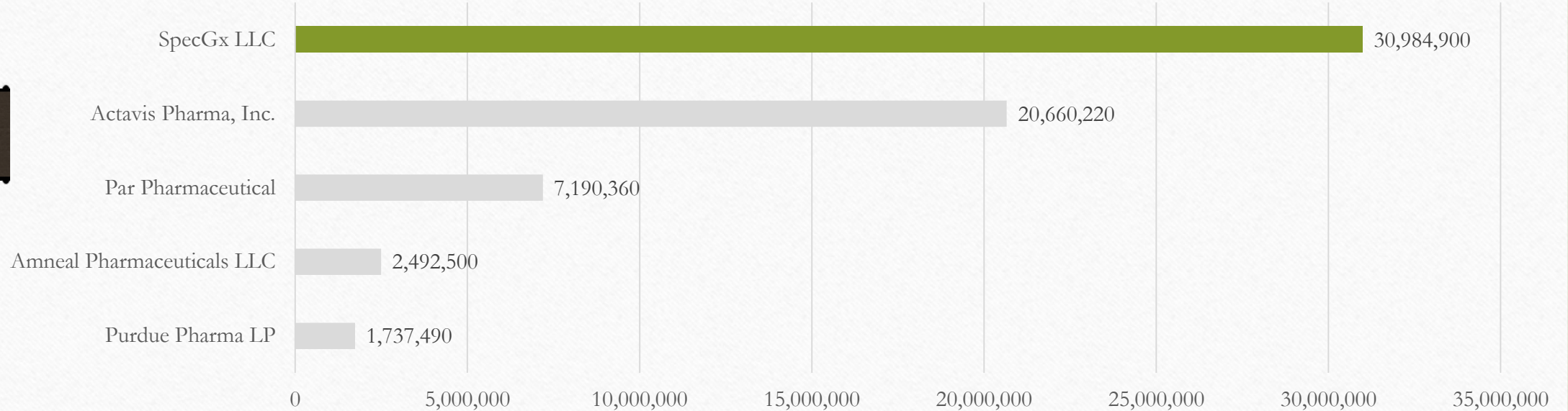

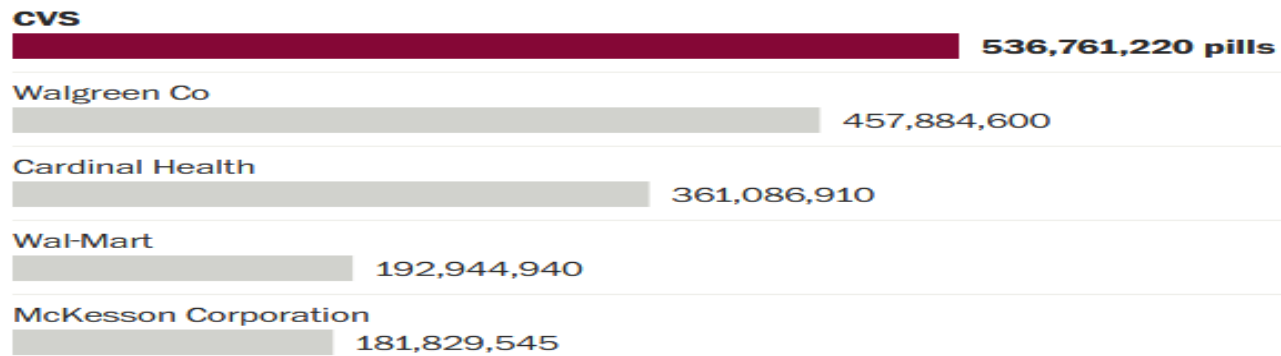

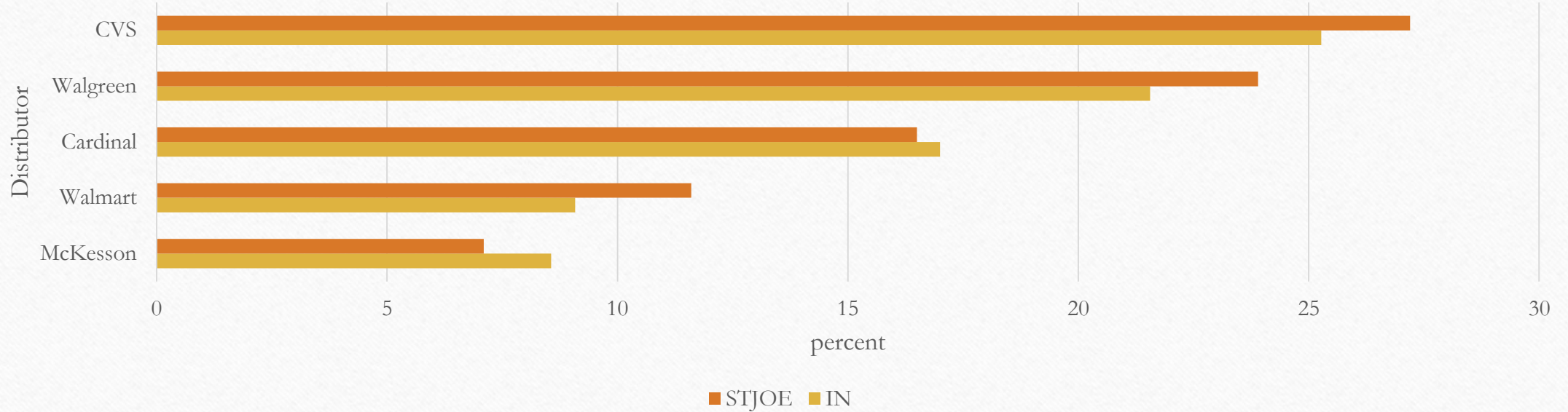

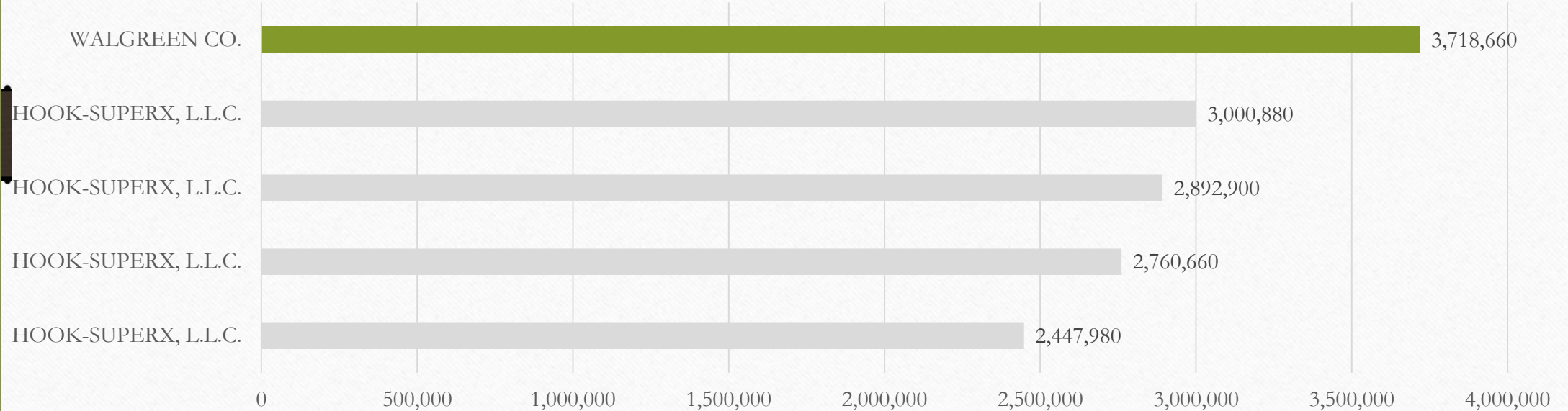

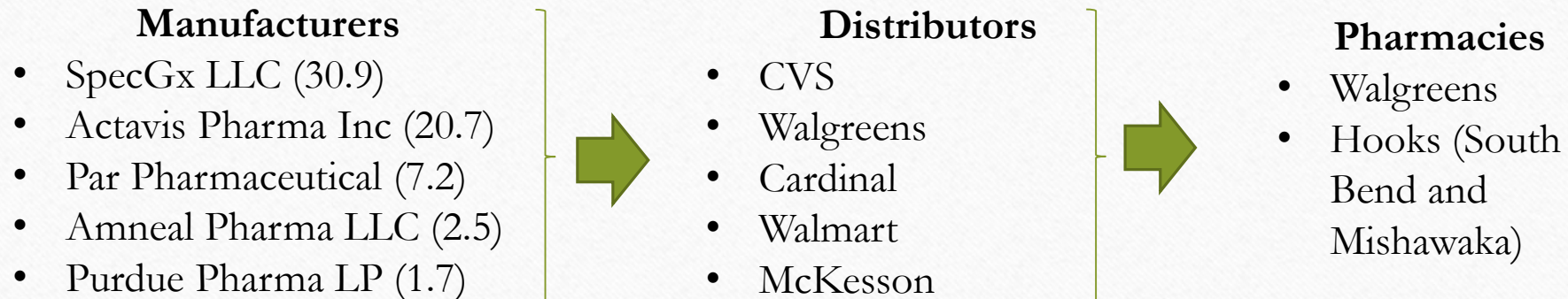

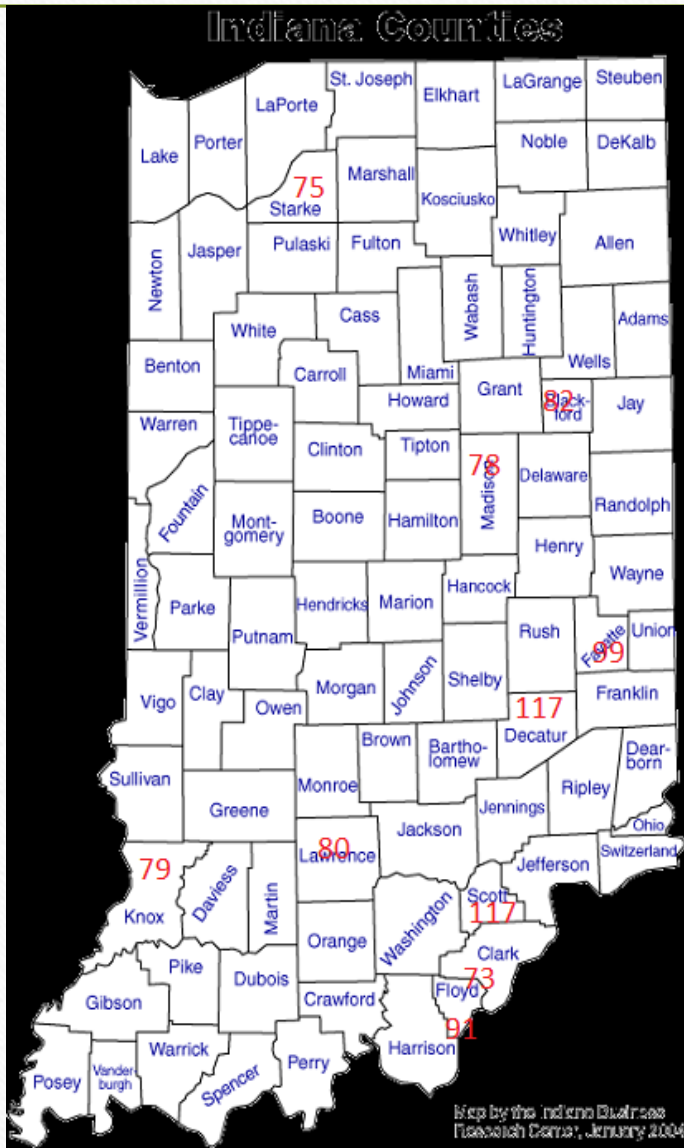

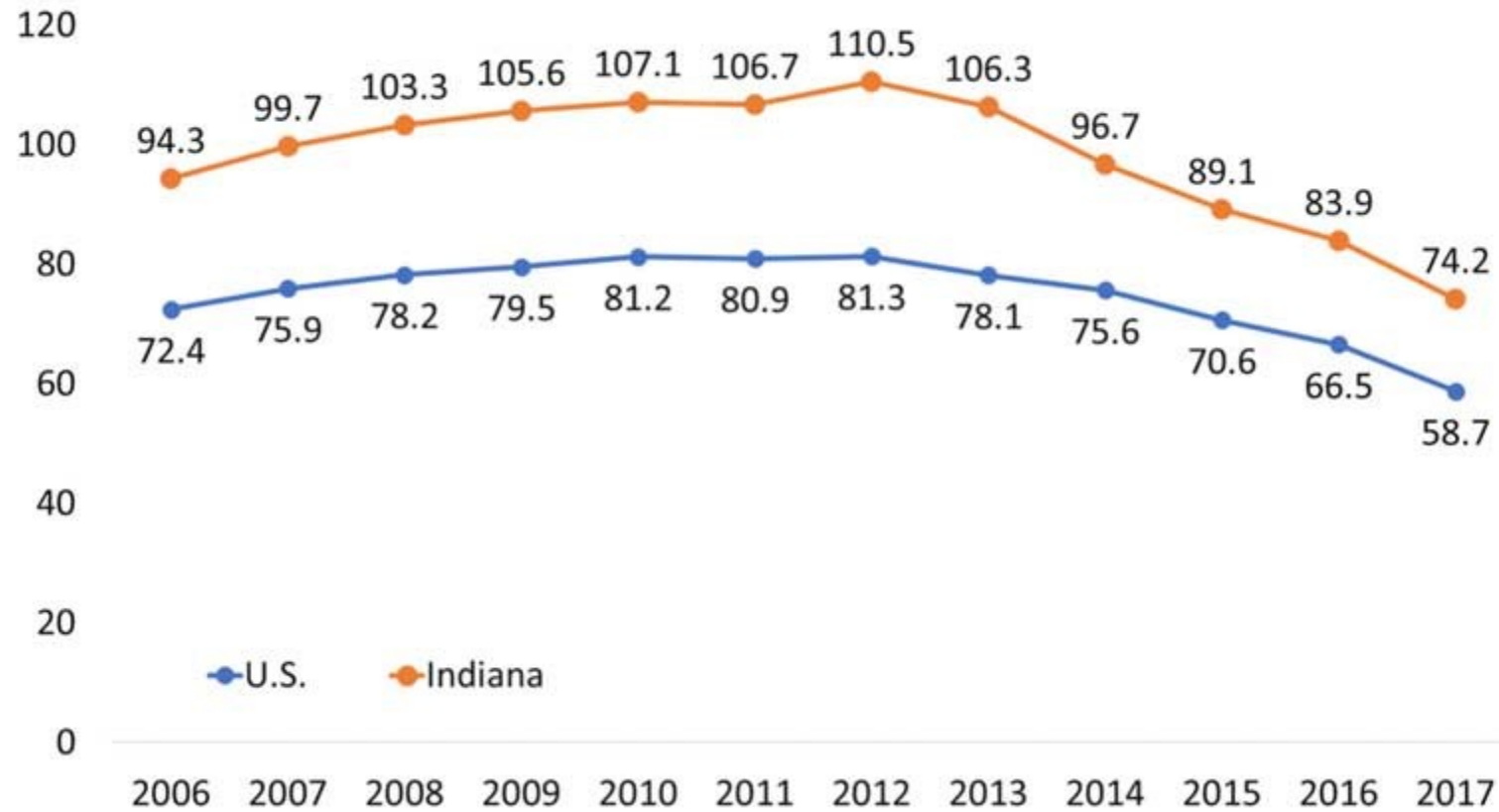

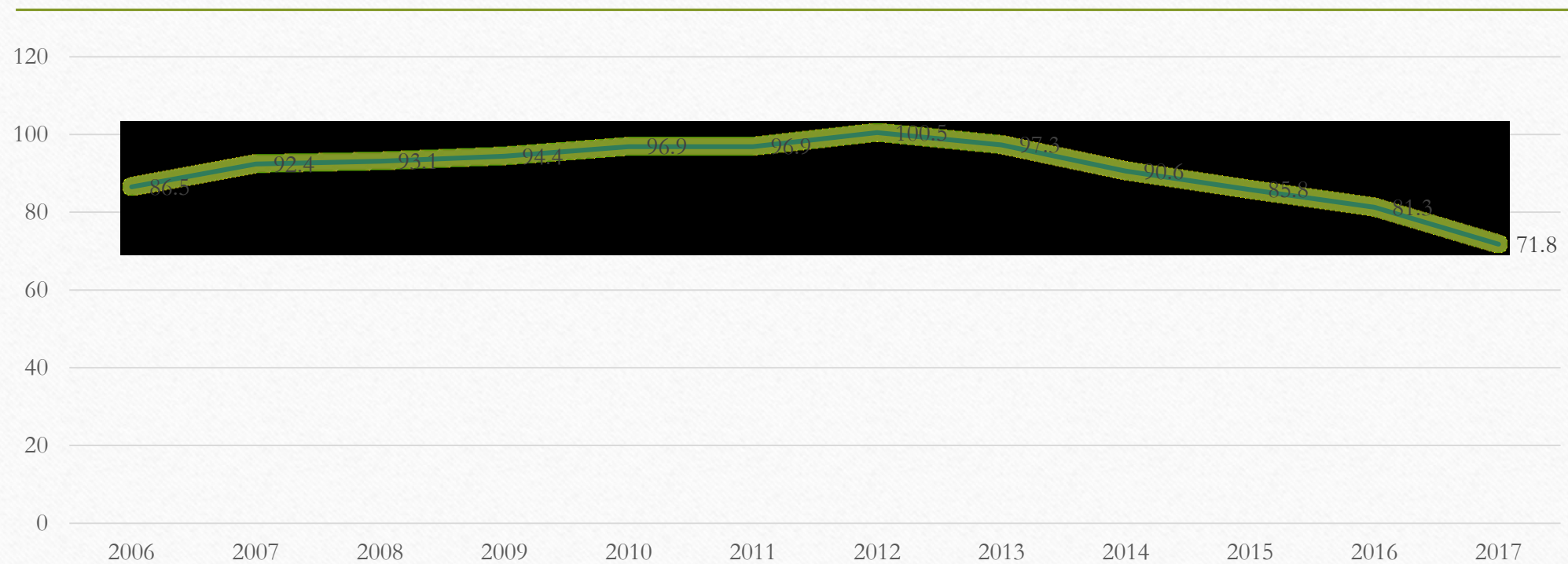

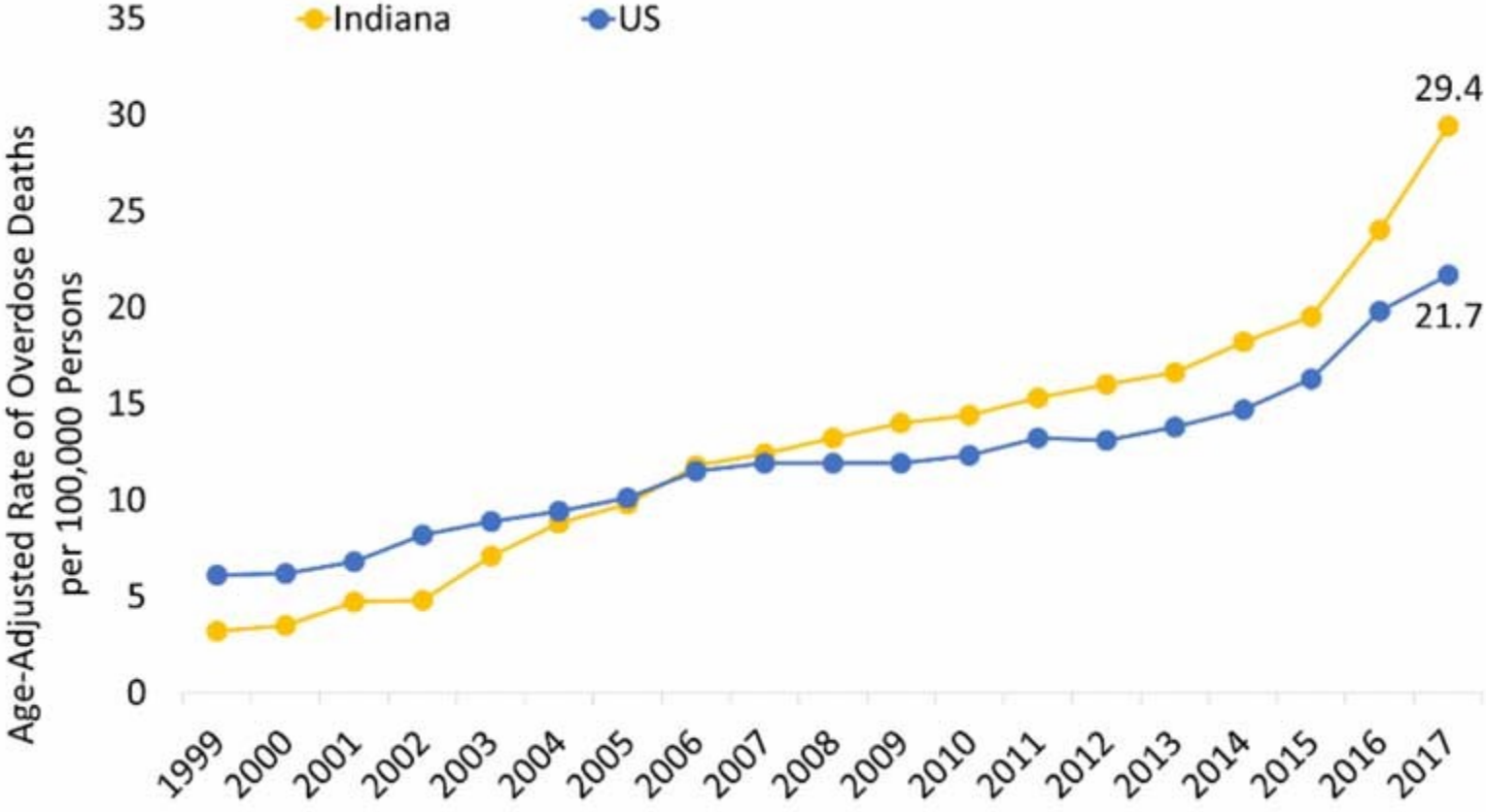


Retail opioid prescriptions dispensed per 100 persons per year St. Joseph County, 2006-2017
